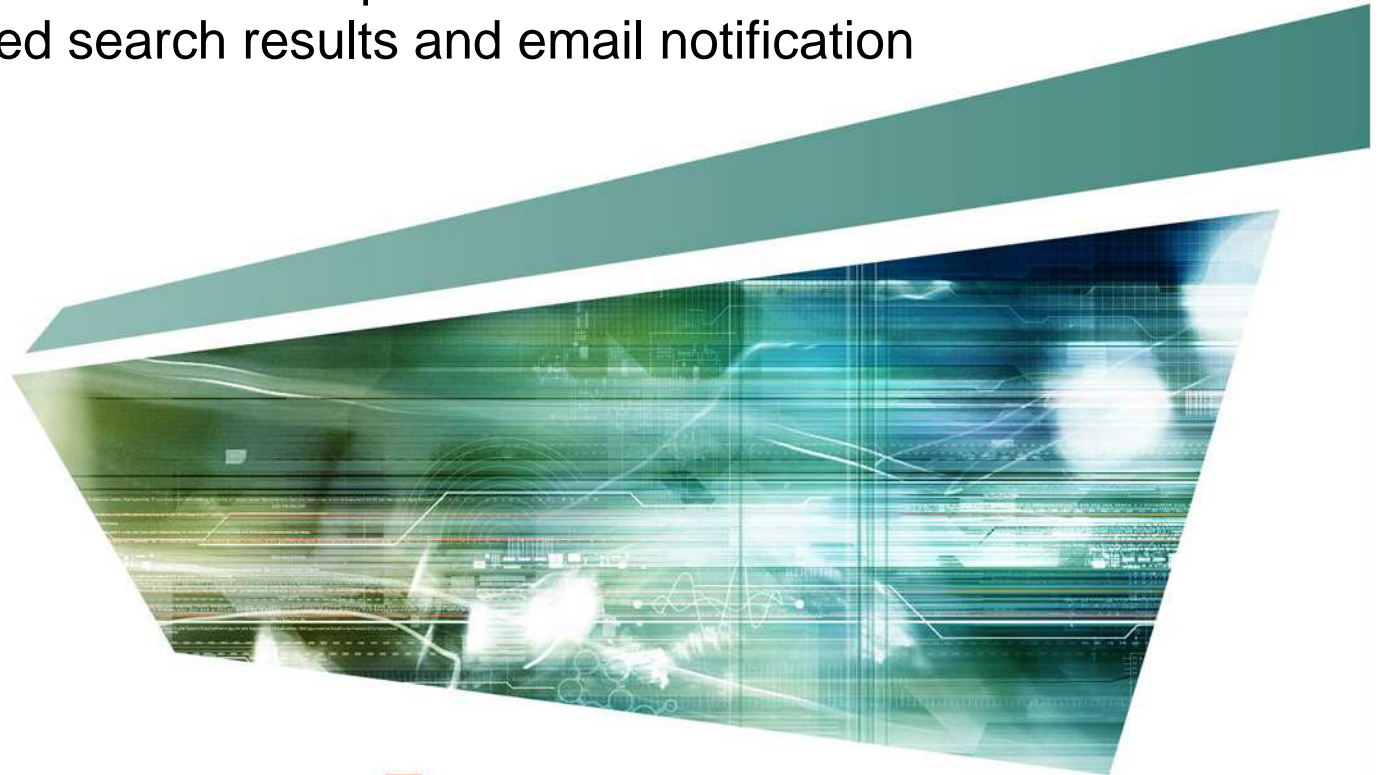

Get Started – Set Preferences in 3 Steps

- SourceLink Preferences helps you get precisely the information you need, when you need it—

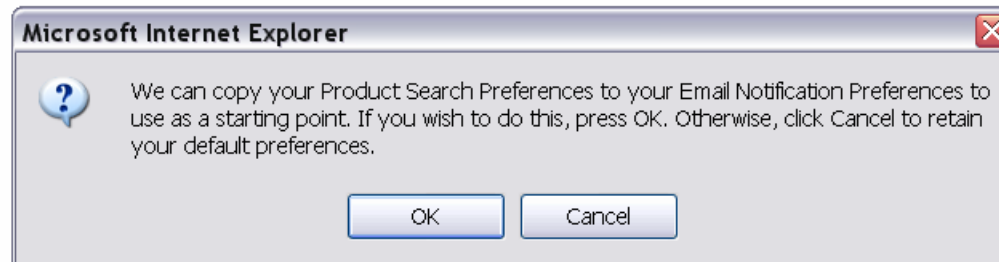

- Results are shown in order of **Relevance** if keywords are used; **Date** is the default if keyword field is left blank.
- Change the sort order by clicking on the **Sort by** radio button.
- Hide or Show contextual **Summaries** and document **Attributes**
- Use multiple keywords
- Place **quotes** around two or more words to find documents that contain a phrase.
Examples:
“physical design flow”
“physical design” flow
“physical design”
“flow guide”
