### Abstract

An abstract of maximum 150 - 250 words should be appropriate for this section. The word "Abstract" should be Arial, 14pt, bolded, initially capitalized and centered above the abstract text. The spacing for the word "Abstract": 18pt before and 12pt after. The text of this section should be single spaced, Arial, 12pt, non-bolded. Very important, in all the sections the text must be justified, except where is clearly specified other requirement. The spacing for this section: 0pt before and 12pt after.

**Keywords:** List four to six descriptive words across the page. The spacing for this section: 0pt before and 12pt after. The word "Keywords" should be Arial, 12pt, bolded, aligned to left. The text of this section should be Arial, 10pt, non-bolded.

### Main Title and Title of Paragraphs (Headings)

Very important, the two-page abstract must clearly state what is NEW in the paper with respect to the state of the art. The main title should be easily readable, Arial, 18pt, bolded, initially capitalized and centered above the abstract text. In the main title, do not capitalize articles, coordinate conjunctions, and prepositions under four letters in length. The main title should have a spacing of 12pt before the title (between the logo and the title) and 6pt after. The main title should be followed by the section with the details of the author(s), Arial, 12pt, centered. Only the names of author(s) will be bolded. The spacing for this section: 0pt before and 6pt after.

The titles of paragraphs should be Arial, 12pt, bolded, initially capitalized, left-aligned above the paragraph text. Do not capitalize articles, coordinate conjunctions, and prepositions under four letters in length. The spacing for titles of paragraphs (headings): 12pt before and 6pt after.

### Format of Your Abstract

Use A4 format for your two-page abstract. All printed materials, including texts, figures, illustrations, tables, and charts must be kept within the parameters of the one-column format. Left, right, top and bottom margins should each be 25mm. Succeeding pages will have a 25mm top margin. We strongly advise you to use the present document as the official template and to introduce your text/figures/tables in it Print out these instructions before pasting your work into this document, so you can refer back to it. Regarding the names of paragraphs, we recommend the following: **Introduction and Motivation of Work, Results, Conclusions, Acknowledgements, and References.**

## Type Style and Size

The text of all sections should be Arial, 10pt, non-bolded, justified. Text should be single-spaced. The spacing for all sections: 0pt before and 6pt after.

## Figures/graphs/photographs and tables

The figures, graphs, tables and photographs may fit with the text, but can be smaller, if necessary. Figures, graphs, and photographs should be colour or B&W of high quality, centered on the page.

Figure/graph/photograph and table captions should be Arial, 9pt, and centered but not bolded, as presented below. The spacing for all captions: 3pt before and 3pt after. The spacing for a figure/graph/photograph: 12pt before and 0pt after.

The caption is placed above the table and below the figure/graph/photograph. As general rule, each figure/graph/photograph or table should occupy one-fourth to one-third of a page.

Do NOT place page numbers on the manuscript. This will be done by the publishers. You are asked to limit the abstract to two pages. Papers should be submitted in Microsoft Word format or Adobe Acrobat PDF format. Please follow carefully the instructions given in this template. Name the files with corresponding author's last name at the beginning and with "CDNLive2019" at the end (for example: **Codreanu\_abstract\_CDNLive2019.doc** and **Codreanu\_abstract\_CDNLive2019.pdf**).
